



2. Membership

The following persons will be eligible as the members of the Society.

- a) A citizen of India who has completed eighteen years of age at the time of his/her application for such admission .

7. Suspension from membership

10. Meetings of the General Body

Annual General meeting

The Annual General Meeting of the Society shall consist of all the members of the General Body The quorum at the Annual General Meeting of the Society shall be 25% of total membership and at least 55% of voting members. Should this quorum not be reached, the assembly shall be convened again, at the same place, 24 hours later; its decisions shall be valid whatever the number of members present. The Annual General Meeting shall be convened not later than 30th June in each year. The Secretary shall notify all members of the Society of the time and place of the meeting by letter sent no less than 4 weeks prior to the date of the meeting.
